Ecological Education for Children





Ecological education within a holistic framework focuses on empowering, transforming, developing consciousness among students. Ecology, social justice, and authentic forms of educational assessment are included in holistic education. Children are part of their ecosystem and have a right to learn how to work with, not their surrounding destroy, ecosystem in order to connect, respect, nurture, and develop a connection other livina to organisms.

Vital factors which for children's and all people's survival. Students' natural surroundings, communities, and the planet are integral domains of their lives. Individuals are part of a natural system that directly and indirectly affect each other. Schools are micro-systems of a larger system; unfortunately, they have become alienated from those larger systems, such as their surrounding communities and the natural environment surrounding the schools.

Ecological education is not only about global warming, acid rain, biodiversity, and the disappearance of forests.

But it also includes, economics, population, risk analysis, public policy, social justice, earth as a living system, and developing in students not only awareness but an understanding of ecological issues.

Ecological education within a holistic approach has the power to construct positive connections between school and society. Furthermore, ecological promotes sustainable education development consistent with teaching the whole child and educates for sustainability from an interconnected pattern. Eco-literacy has the ability to raise awareness for the need to protect the environment, health, and living systems. Living systems include not only plants and animals, but also human beings. Ecological education also develops relations between students nature and promotes understanding on how individual and collective decisions influence the environment and ecosystems. Ecology develops students' relation to other organisms, to one another, and helps them make the correct choices regarding the planet.

Sustainable Building Practices: Various dimensions of Ferro-cement technology

Ferro-Cement Technology:


One of the important cost-effective construction solutions which is also eco-friendly is Ferro-cement technology. It reduces use of wood for the construction of doors, windows etc. It is also useful in building water storage structures that can be used for community purposes. However the problem is the propagation of this technology,

Our approach to the problem of technology dissemination has been at various levels. One important innovation by VK-nardep is the valueaddition to this technology. There is synergetic coupling of this technology with other highly adaptable technologies. sustainable integrates Ferro-cement technology as part and parcel of the way of life rather than separate piecemeal technological intervention.



As we also work in the field of rain water harvesting and management of local water resources by community. Here we have introduced the Ferrocement technology for the construction of storage tanks. This community structures as well as household water storage structures made of Ferrocement make them affordable for the rural communities and also help in technology dissemination.

VK-nardep also uses the Ferro-Cement technology in the fabrication of the fixed model plant of Shakthi-Surabhi. Shakthi-Surabhi is a highly successful model of bio-methanation plant that we had innovated and disseminating. It produces gas from domestic-kitchen waste.






The above photographs show how the ferro-cement technology can be used in creating important social infrastructure for rural areas like toilet buildings and gates for village commons.








Happenings: This month for Sustainable Agriculture





Further Happenings: **This** month Networking




This month... Shakthi Surabhi

- True spiritual life is that which teaches unity or oneness and makes us selfless and full of love.






Books by Fritjof Capra: an exploration





Fritjof Capra, a particle physicist turned author and deep-ecologist is a well-known figure in India. His popularity is because of the pathbreaking book 'Tao of Physics' where he draws parallel between the eastern wisdom and the worldviews that are emerging at the cutting edge of modern physics. The book created some of the most powerful images that would last forever etched in our consciousness. like the bubble particle chamber sub atomic trajectories superimposed on the photo negative of a Chola bronze Nataraja.

Since then Capra has gone forward and expanded his vision to study how the paradigm shift in physics is spreading over to other fields like medicine, psychology and even economics. The result of this study is the book 'Turning Point'.



Conceptualized by Thomas Kuhn, Capra popularized the word 'Paradigm Shift' without diluting its meaning.


His book 'Uncommon Wisdom' is a collection of interviews. This book in a way shows us how his inner views and integral approach to varied disciplines took shape. Here Capra interviews Heisenberg, one of the foremost architects of Quantum mechanics who corroborates Capra's own intuition about the parallels between eastern wisdom and the worldview of new physics.



He also talks with molecular biologists, psychiatrists, politicians and economists. This is an important book for anyone who wants to understand Capra's own inner development.

His next important book is 'The Web of Life' where he revealed the new integrative developments in the study of the origin of life and consciousness. Here he explored the works of biologists Humberto Maturana and Francisco Varela. He pointed out how biology is rapidly moving towards a holistic conception of life from the reductionist framework of molecular biology.

He went on to write 'Hidden connections' that explored the social evolution in the context of our understanding of new biology.



His latest book 'The Science of Leonardo' explores how Leonardo's journey to science through art makes him an important pioneer of systems' science or holistic science

Science of human possibilities

The great men of the past have given us glimpses of what is possible in the way of personality, of intellectual understanding, of spiritual achievement, of artistic creation. But these are scarcely more than Pisgah glimpses. We need to explore and map the whole realm of human possibility, as the realm of physical geography has been explored and mapped. Knowledge and Wisdom


Few of us ever try to still the mind, but in reality, it is from the still mind that many wondrous discoveries and inventions have taken birth.
