

### A new beginning -Renovation of Srivilliputhur temple tank

In the state of Tamil Nadu is having the maximum number of temples – both big and small. Majority of the temples are having their own water tanks which has multiple usages. Unfortunately, majority of these tanks are not in good shape for the following reasons:

- i. No proper inlet and thus no water in the tank
- ii. No regular de-silting and upkeep
- iii. Converting the tank into garbage bin
- iv. Encroachment
- v. No ownership by the stakeholders

Keeping the above issues in mind, Vivekananda Kendra – Nardep decided to take up a few steps like a Rama's squirrel in rejuvenating the temple tanks at a few places. We decided to make a beginning with Andal Temple of Srivilliputhur, in Virudhunagar district as it is the state symbol of Tamil Nadu.

It is located 80 km from Madurai. The temple is glorified the Divya Prabandha, the early medieval Tamil canon of the Alvar saints from the 6th-9th centuries AD. Ιt is 108 Divyadesam dedicated to Vishnu, who is worshipped as Vatapatrasayi and his consort Lakshmi as Andal. It is believed to be the birthplace of two of the Alvars. namely Periyalvar and his foster daughter Andal.

Before starting the work, VK-Nardep team visited Srivilliputhur town on 8<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and surveyed most of the major tanks such as (i) Vadamalai kurichi tank (ii) Tiruvannamalai - Kovanagiri tank (iii) Thirumakulam (iv) Teertham inside the school (v) Nataka salai Teertham (vi) Chaktra Kulam (vii) Vaitheeswaran temple tank.

Shri.G.Vasudeo, and Shri.V.Ramakrishnan VKnardep interacted with the prominent members of Srivilliputhur before surveying the tanks. The following members joined the survey team.


