Anxiety - An Attitude of Irreligious Person

Extracts from the book – The ABC of Enlightment by OSHO



Anxiety means, "There is nobody to look after me. I have to carry the whole burden on my own shoulders. If I don't carry it then I am finished". The anxious person thinks, "Everybody is against me. Somehow, everybody is conspiring against me, everybody is at my throat.

I have to protect myself. I have to be watchful, I have to plan, I have to move in such a way that I become the winner. Everybody is a competitor and they are all bent upon defeating me".

This attitude creates anxiety, and it is the attitude of an irreligious person. When I say an irreligious person, I don't mean a person who does not go to temple or read the scriptures - that is not the point. A person may go to temple, but if he remains in anxiety, he is not religious. He may be praying to God and reading the scriptures just because of his anxiety. He may do it as a kind of protection, security. But such a person is not religious. He is pathological and his religion will be pathological.


The truly religious person knows nothing of anxiety; he changes the whole gestalt. He says, "I am part of this whole existence, and if trees are not worried and the birds are not going crazy and mad and the animals are utterly happy, why can't I be? I belong to this existence; I am an essential part of it". This trust, this understanding, this faith means that anxiety simply disappears, you have stopped creating it.

Then so much energy is released that it starts overflowing. It is so abundant, so exuberant, that life becomes a festival. It becomes a dance. Then you are religious, then you are drunk with the divine.

Case Study - Osteoarthritis

Dr.Muthushanthi, Varma Research and Resource Center, Vivekananda Kendra – Nardep, Kanyakumari

A 52 y old female from villukuri, who is a home maker reported to the varmam OPD of Siddha in Vivekanandha Kendra - Nardep on 23.10.2022 with chief complaints of pain and swelling in both knee joints, affecting walking ability preventing to go up or down stairs since 5 years. She was mentally stressed due to chronic intermittent pain.

Present complaints: Pain and swelling in both knee joints which affecting walking ability and not able to climb up and down stairs since 5 years.

Past History: There is no history of trauma, fall

Co-morbid conditions: Nil

Medical history: She was previously treated with NSAIDs for 6 month with frequent intervals.

Medical history: She was previously treated with NSAIDs for 6 month with frequent intervals.

Personal history: Normal body built, Mixed diet habit, Non-smoker and Non-alcoholic.

Observation/ palpation: Oedema at the anterior/superior aspect of the knee joints and smaller size of oedema at the medial/superior aspect of the knee, tender to palpation.

Diagnostic focus: The clinical examination and x-ray of both knee joints confirmed the diagnosis as osteoarthritis of both knee joints. As per the Kellgren and Lawrence grading system for radiographic evidence, the present case falls under grade 2 Osteoarthritis (definite osteophytes, definite narrowing of joint space).

Therapeutic focus:
Internal (Arogya capsules 2 - two times a day) and External Medicines (Vatha varma Thylam) along with Varmam therapy



Before treatment: The pain score before treatment was 6/10. Odeama on both kness.

After Treatment: The pain score after treatment was 1/10. The pain score and the degree of range of movements were assessed on every visit.

Conclusion: Osteoarthritis is the major cause for knee replacement. The analgesics and anti-inflammatory drugs cannot be administered on long term. It is found that Internal Medicines along with Varmam therapy is helpful for patients in early stages of osteoarthritis may prevent the development of deformities and surgical intervention. Today's status is good, the patient reports with very mild pain.




Hallmarks of Indian Civilization
