



Green House Effect

Venus is the ultimate example of a carbon-di-oxide green house that has gone too far. Its atmosphere is almost pure carbon-di-oxide, and its surface temperature, at nearly 900 degrees Fahrenheit, is enough to melt lead.

Some might say that that's not too surprising, since Venus's orbit lies much closer to the heat radiating Sun than our own. That's true enough, but it is not the basic reason for Venus's deadly heat. The other inner planet, Mercury (which is essentially without an atmosphere of any kind) is far closer to the Sun than Venus. Nevertheless, Venus is hotter than Mercury.




