


Renewable Energy

New Frame of Reference

James Lovelock suffered stinging attacks from people who thought he was too emotional. But his concept of Gaia, the Earth as a homeostatic system that regulates itself that SO environmental factors such as temperature range, salinity, redox-effect, acidity, mixture of the atmosphere. cloudiness etc. remain within what is appropriate for life, lends itself both to a strictly scientific interpretation and to mythological ways of looking at the world, which is what most people need.



Indian Philosophy antidote to Cartesian Partition

"The Cartesian Partition, has penetrated deeply into the human mind during the three centuries following Descartes, and it will take a long time for it to be replaced by a really different attitude toward the problem of Reality".

In 1920, Heisenberg spent some time in India with poet Rabindranath Tagore, with whom he had long conversations about science and Indian Philosophy. This introduction brought Heisenberg great comfort. He began to see the recognition of relativity, interconnectedness, the impermanence as fundamental aspects of physical reality, which had been so difficult for himself and his fellow physicists, was the very basis of the Indian spiritual tradition.
