It makes to think of eagles, they are not soaring to impress me.

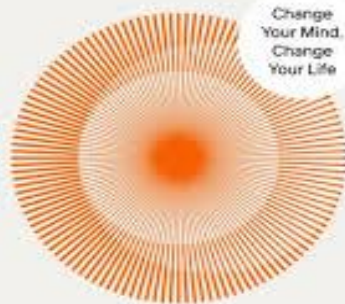
Humans are the only animals

I'm dismantling my image. We are perfect in our flaws.

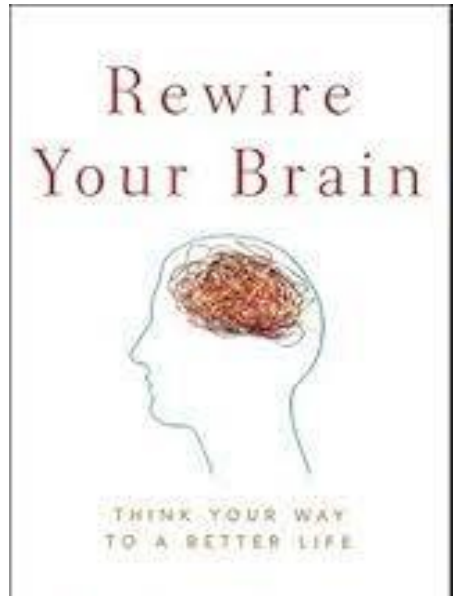
Birds don't care whether we listen, they don't wait for our applause.

So if you go to heaven, are you still aware of hell. Wow



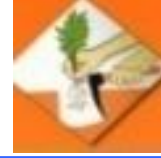

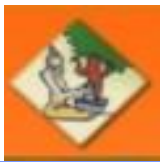

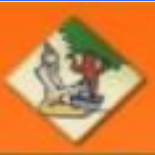

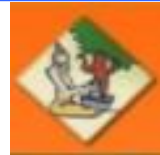
